Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Excerpt from The Mummer: And Other Poems When I wrote The Mummer, I was not aware that the conversion and martyrdom of St. Genesius, the comedian, formed the ground-plot on which Rotrou, the friend and precursor of le grand Corneille, built one of his noblest tragedies. His tragedy - a tragedy within a tragedy - has, however, little in common with the simple narrative as set forth in the Lives of the Saints, and, indeed, the naive pathos and the uncouth medieval humour of the original would have been but little adapted to the stately style of his day. The title of his play, St. Genest, is misleading, as I find that St. Genest, or Genestius, was Bishop of Clermont-Ferrand, but Rotrou possibly adopted that orthography for the sake of euphony. I know of no metrical version of the story in English, but this, I fear, may be a confession of culpable ignorance, as I can hardly suppose that I am the first to have been tempted by so striking a subject.
